HCMC EMS Room 115/117 **(located in the EMS Dept. on first floor of the HCMC parking ramp)**

HCMC Parking Ramp

Location

The entrances to the HCMC Parking Ramp (shown as “1” on the map) are at **615 S. 6th St.** and **614 S. 7th St.** (between Park and Portland Avenues). If you have a GPS mapping system or wish to use internet mapping, use the addresses above to map to the ramp entrance. You can also use the directions below.

Handicapped-accessible parking is located on the 6th level of the ramp near the elevators.

To get to EMS Room 115/117: Take the parking ramp elevators down to level 1. Enter the EMS Emergency and Critical Care Education Department. There is a pay coffee machine and bathrooms located within the department.



Food can be accessed in HCMC coffee shops and cafeteria through the skyway system on 2nd floor. A coffee shop is located in the Purple building on 2nd floor near where the skyway connects the Red and Purple buildings together. The cafeteria is located on 3rd floor of the Orange building.

Directions to the HCMC Parking Ramp:

From the Northwest

94 East to Exit 230 (4th Street). Follow 4th Street to Portland Ave.; turn right. Go to South 6th Street and turn left. Enter HCMC parking ramp on your right.

From the Northeast

I-35W south to the Washington Avenue South exit. Turn right onto Washington Avenue and go several blocks to Portland Avenue and turn left. Go to South 6th Street and turn left. Enter HCMC parking ramp on your right.

From the East

94 West to Exit 234B (5th Street). Follow 5th Street around the Dome; turn left onto Portland Ave. Go to South 6th Street and turn left. Enter HCMC parking ramp on your right.

From the South

35W North to Exit 16A (Downtown). Take 5th Avenue and follow 5th Avenue to South 6th Street and turn right. Enter the HCMC parking ramp on your right.

From the West

394 East to Exit 9B (6th Street). Follow 6th Street to the HCMC Parking ramp (just past Portland Ave. on the right side).

The program coordinator will have a limited number of discount coupons for the HCMC Ramp available for \$7.00. You must pay with cash or check in the exact amount for the discount coupon—change is not available.

Other transportation and parking options:

For bus schedules and information, go to www.metrotransit.org. **Light Rail Transit to HCMC:** HCMC is located at the corner of Park Ave. and 6th Street, conveniently located just 1-1/2 blocks south of the Downtown East/Metrodome station of the Light Rail Transit line. Light Rail information is available at www.metrotransit.org/rail/index.asp. There are also parking meters and other parking lots and ramps in the area. Discounted parking is only available in the HCMC Parking Ramp. If walking to HCMC from another area, please enter the Purple building and take the 2nd floor skyway to the parking ramp elevators down to the first floor of the parking ramp.
